Reminders from Timm B. and Tarrence D.: Webmasters

As you can imagine, there is no one way to connect with all of the members of the Chapter. Some members visit the website regularly. Others primarily use Facebook. And yes, there are some members who only get updates via text messages.

As the Webmasters for the Chapter, we support several channels to connect with the members. Here's a brief overview of what is supported.

Chapter Website

The Chapter website <u>http://www.dhdhog.com</u> is used to provide information of interest to the members.

- The most important part of the website is the Chapter Calendar. This is the most up-to-date source of information for events that are planned. The Calendar enables members to "sign up" for various events. Although not mandatory, members are strongly encouraged to sign up whenever they plan to participate for two reasons:
 - 1. If the event is a ride, it will let the road captains know who plans to participate and will wait up until the "Kick Stands Up" (KSU) time for all riders to arrive. If all signed up riders are present at the scheduled start time then the road captain may elect to start the ride before KSU time.
 - 2. If the event involves a meal, then it will let the organizer of the meeting know how many seats will be needed at the restaurant.
- The "Members Only" section includes two important features that members frequently use:
 - 1. The "View Event Signups" section that shows a list of the Chapter members that have signed up for each event. This allows members to see who else will be attending as well as allowing road captains and event organizers to get a count of participants. Note that events that are organized by Defiance Harley Davidson, and not the Chapter, will not be listed.
 - 2. The "Chapter Mileage Challenge" section is used by mileage challenge participants to record their mileage on their bike(s). Participants in the Challenge are eligible for prizes at the end of the riding season. Thus, it is to your advantage to participate.
- There are a number of other features of the website that members will occasionally visit. Things such as the News feed, Photo Albums, and the Trivia challenge are several that you may want to review on a regular basis.

DHDHOG Omaha Facebook Group

The Chapter has recently created a "members only" Facebook group: <u>DHDHOG Omaha</u>. One of the most popular features of this Group is that it enables member-to-member communication. Members are sharing photos, fun activities not directly related to the Chapter as well as messages and events that are also included in the Chapter Website. Note that the Chapter website is still considered to be "authoritative source" for Chapter events.

Of course, you must have a Facebook account in order to join the Facebook Group. If you haven't joined the Group yet and you try to post to the Group you're request to post will be forwarded to one of the admins for approval. As soon as the approval is submitted your post will appear. All subsequent posts will be automatically approved.

Text Messaging

Just about every member has the ability to receive text messages on their cell phone. The Chapter will send text messages to members (who have explicitly signed up) to remind them of upcoming events or notify them in case of an event cancellation. Since some cell phone plans charge for sending and receiving text messages, the Chapter is using a service that requires members to "sign up" to receive text messages. The Chapter cannot add a member's cell phone number. The Chapter currently supports 4 "Groups" for text messages:

- 1. **DHDMEMBERS** is the group for all Chapter members, including officers.
- 2. DHDLOH is the group for members of Ladies of Harley.
- **3. DHDVOLUNTEERS** is a group to send messages to members who would like be informed when a Chapter member needs assistance of some type. It could be helping an injured member with yard work, giving a ride to a medical facility when needed, or other light chores that the member is unable to do on their own.
- **4. DHDOFFICERS** is a group that is limited to Chapter officers. This is primarily used to remind officers of upcoming meetings.

Members may add their cell phones to these messaging groups by sending a text message to **84483** that contains the name of the group that they wish to join.

Summary

We are always looking for ways to improve communication with the Chapter's members. We realize that not all events are of interest to all members. However, we want to ensure that members are aware of what's happening, so they can decide what is of interest or not. And, not miss an event that they would have liked to have joined. If you have suggestions on how to improve our communications with the Chapter please contact an officer with your idea.

Calendar of Events

Chapter activities are conducted primarily for the benefit of H.O.G. chapter members. There are three categories of activities. All activities are identified as follows:

Closed events are for chapter members and one guest per member.

Member events are reserved for H.O.G. members only.

Open events are chapter events open to chapter members, national H.O.G. members and other guests.

ALL DHD Omaha Chapter activities are "Closed Events", unless stated otherwise.
